Use in brewing:

Dual purpose hop. Bobek has an intense and pleasant hoppy aroma. Beer prepared with this variety has good organoleptical scores for its bitterness and aroma.

Substitutions:

Fuggles, Willamette

Origin/History:

Bobek is a diploid hybrid between Northern Brewer and a TG seedling of unknown origin.

Agronomics:

Medium late variety. The rootstock is susceptible to downy mildew, the leaves are resistant and the cones slightly susceptible. It is grown on moderately deep and deep clay soil.
