Use in brewing:

Dual purpose hop. An experimental variety which is under evaluation by UK and US brewers. It has quite floral qualities similar to that of Cascade.

Substitutions:

Cascade, Columbus

Origin/History:

Selected from a cross between Brewers Gold and a selected USDA male.

Agronomics:

Good, neat well hopped vines maturing mid-season. A medium sized dense compact cone. No visible reaction to infection with Prunus necrotic ring-spot virus. Moderately resistant to Verticillium Wilt.

Storage:

Moderate.
