The English variety Northdown is a direct descendant of Northern Brewer and has very similar brewing characteristics. Used as a Dual-Purpose variety it gives excellent bittering properties and a pleasant aroma.

**Substitutions:**

Brewers Gold, Chinook, Perle

**Origin/History:**

Developed from a cross between a male seedling of Brewers Gold with Canterbury Golding in the 1940s.
