**Use in brewing:**

Aroma hop. The aroma has similar characteristics to one of its parents in Northern Brewer.

Substitutions:

Northern Brewer

Origin/History:

Initially bred some time before 1970 in Belgium, it is the child of Northern Brewer and Saaz through open pollination.

Agronomics:

Matures early season.

Record is known to have a moderate resistance to downy mildew, though is known to have several viruses such as prunus necrotic ringspot, hop mosaic and hop latent.

Poor to Moderate.
